### 2018 CAMPSITE AGREEMENT:

- 1. One camper or tent per campsite. Campsites are to the left of the yellow numbered "Cow" tag.
- 2. Two (2) vehicles per campsite-visitors may park on the main lot.
- 3. No generators or ATVs are allowed on the site. No discharge of firearms.
- 4. If the water rises excessively, permission is granted for you to move your camper to higher ground as designated by the site manager. Further, campers are responsible to move their own camper/trailer.
- 5. No buildings or structures of any kind.
- 6. The first 15 feet from the Swatara is for public walkway or fishing.
- 7. One picnic table is supplied per campsite. Fasten the table to a tree to avoid loss during a flood.
- 8. One fire ring is supplied per campsite.
- 9. Under no circumstances shall wood with nails be brought onto the property. To control invasive species, imported firewood must be from within a 50-mile radius. No cutting of live trees.
- 10. Camper must clean and maintain his or her own campsite. Equipment is not supplied.
- 11. No excessive noise.
- 12. Pets must be leashed on your lot. No more than two dogs per campsite. Excessive barking will not be tolerated.
- 13. No alcoholic parties of any kind, and No drugs.
- 14. Lessee must take their own garbage home weekly.
- 15. No discharging or planting of any non-native plant species.
- 16. No dishwashing detergent may be discharged onto the ground.
- 17. No washing vehicles. The 5mph speed limit must be obeyed at all times.
- 18. Self-contained units must use their own sewerage system.
- 19. All units must leave the premises at least once every thirty (30) days per Township Ordinance.
- 20. All units <u>and gear</u> must be removed from the property by November 1. Otherwise, a disposal charge will be assessed, and must be paid in full prior to renewing for another camping season.
- 21. The gate is to be locked each evening. From sunset to sunrise, you shall relock the gate after entering or leaving the grounds.
- 22. Camper must also sign a liability release form.
- 23. Quiet hours are observed between 11PM and 6AM.

Persons in violation of any rules and regulations will be evicted without reimbursement of donation. I understand and will abide by all rules.

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Attention Campers:

We look forward to another season of camping along the Swatara. For your information, an entrance gate is being installed at this time. Further, three Eagle Scouts have completed their projects at Swatara Watershed Park: Austin Barry completed renovation of the boat launch through an Eagle Scout project in partnership with the Northern Lebanon Rotary Club, the Swatara Watershed Association, and others; Slade Hall constructed additional picnic tables including handicap accessible tables with advisor Lenny Else; and Sean Blade collected, power washed, and stained all of the existing picnic tables at the Park. Fire companies also approached SWA for access involving search and rescue. Further, we may grant fire companies access for training exercises.

We held the line on the donation per one family campsite for the 2018 camping season. The donation will be \$450. Lot donation must be received in full by May 1, 2018. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!** Please note that some municipalities are implementing MS4 plans, and assessing properties for impervious surfaces. We don't know how this will impact our site for next year.

No other person is permitted to have and/or use the provided gate combination. If campers do not contact SWA and **make arrangements by May 1, 2018**, specific previously used sites will not be guaranteed.

## **REMINDERS:**

- 1. Campers are expected and required to pick up any and all firewood, cans, bottles, camping equipment, chairs...after high water. No planting of non-native species, and permanent structures may NOT be erected.
- 2. So they don't float away, tables are required to be tied or chained to a tree.
- 3. As a camper, you have the right to question any person you feel does not belong on the premises after dark, or at any time if they are breaking any laws. Get their names and license plate numbers if possible, but do not put yourself in harms way. Call 911 to report suspicious activity.
- 4. Toilet service for the 2018 camping season will be supplied by Walter's, 650 Firehouse Rd., Grantville PA, exclusively. Call 1-888-265-3581 for service.
- 5. A <u>liability release also requires your signature</u>, and must be witnessed by an SWA Board member or notarized.
